Bakers Reserve Draft Concept Plan **CONSULTATION PROCESS**

October - November 2023

BACKGROUND

The City of Greater Dandenong have undertaken preparation of a Draft Concept Plan for Bakers Reserve, Noble Park North. Improvements to this reserve were identified as a priority action from the Greater Dandenong, Open Space Strategy 2020-2030.

CONSULTATION

Greater Dandenong City Council asked the community to have their say on the Draft Concept Plan at Bakers Reserve.

The community consultation on the Draft Concept Plan was open for a four-week period Online via the 'Have your say' website from Thursday 2 October until Sunday 5 November 2023. Various methods were used to promote and seek feedback on the Draft Concept Plan.

Council advertised the Draft Concept Plan via the City of Greater Dandenong 'Have Your Say' website with links to SurveyMonkey.

The consultation included:

- Notification posters erected at Bakers Reserve
- Information on Council's website, 'Have Your Say'
- Online survey via Survey Monkey.
- 819 x A4 mailout fliers delivered to the catchment around Bakers Reserve
- In-class workshop with 25 students from St Elizabeth's Primary School (Monday 30 October), and a workshop with students from Dandenong South Primary School.

In total there were 131 responses to the online survey for the draft Concept Plan and one email submission. The online survey response were a compilation of the community members and the feedback received from the St Elizabeth Primary School and Dandenong South Primary School students.






CONSULTATION OUTCOMES DRAFT CONCEPT PLAN ONLINE SURVEY

October -November 2023

The feedback on the draft concept plan has been informed by the community's feedback and the school workshop with the students from St Elizabeth's Primary School.

At St Elizabeth's Primary School there were twenty-five (25) students and one teacher who participated in the classroom presentation. The students were part of the school's leadership group which included children from prep to grade 6. The workshop was facilitated by Council's Children's Services Development Officer, and Council's Senior Landscape Architect and at Dandenong South Primary School, Council's Children's Services Development Officer facilitated the workshop. The in-class presentations on the Draft Concept Plan were based on the online survey monkey questions. However, the workshops allowed for conversations between the students and delved further into the detail of the concept plan. Following this 'deep dive,' the students were then asked to review the draft concept plan and were asked whether they agreed or had further suggestions on how the plan could be improved. There was also an opportunity for the students to provide drawings on their ideas.

The feedback from the in-class workshops has been combined with the broader community feedback and entered into the online survey monkey data to inform and develop the revised draft Concept for Bakers Reserve.

Overall, there was a high level of support for the direction of the concept plan at Bakers Reserve. This is supported by the written responses provided in Question 2, as well as further suggestions on how to improve the park.

The following extracts from the feedback, reflect the general themes from the comments provided:

- Definitely add a futsal court for our soccer loving kids
- It will create a lovely environment for children to play of all ages. The open setting supports a safe environment.
- The existing shelter needs an upgrade and we need to have more than one (shelter with bench and BBQ). I think some exercise equipment for all ages is a must, to encourage people to move more and be healthier! For eg. exercise bike, elliptical, etc like those we see in other parks. Upgrade the existing children's equipment and add more variety like some climbing structures, (again, things that would encourage more movement). I agree with the idea of more

big trees (for shade), garden beds and more benches. Make the pavement for the exercise equipment and children's playground colourful and bright so it's more inviting and motivating for people to play, exercise, have fun and live a healthier life!

- So many kids would utilise this park more if it was upgraded and more was added to it by way of mixed age group activities.
- There are so many young families and kids in the area especially being so close to a school. There is no desire to go and play on that very ancient playground, there is nothing appealing to the kids. With the new suggestions of futsal, basketball, new seating, new playground it can be a great meeting place after school for kids to play.
- Many kids are at the park daily playing soccer and at the playground. It needs an upgrade desperately.
- The park has so much space and so little to do. It needs more play areas and more shelters/seating/bbq areas so local families can come together and not be limited to just 1 at a time.




Overall, there was a very high level of support for the basketball and soccer combination in the court design.





Of the survey entries received, one hundred and nine (109) provided feedback on this question. Most of the feedback was from people over eighteen years old. However, there was a strong representation within the 11-17 age bracket as well as the younger primary school aged children of 6-10 years who were participants in the workshops with the two local schools.

SUMMARY COUNCIL'S RESPONSE TO CONSULTATION OUTCOMES

Overall, there was strong support to make improvements to Bakers Reserve that increase the activities within the park as well as enhance the park's landscape amenity. The main themes and ideas that emerged from the community's comments to the survey have provided council officers with clear direction on both the design and staging of the projects for this park.

The final concept plan is aligned with the following parameters:

- 1. Allocated budget for 2023-2024 financial year
- 2. Neighbourhood level park - Greater Dandenong Open Space Strategy 2020-2030 Park Development Standards
- 3. Neighbourhood level playground Greater Dandenong Playground Strategy 2013-23
- 4. Staging plan to inform future capital improvement works bids to Council

Summary of survey question outcomes on preferred equipment and colours:

Q3 - Preferred sport for the court - basketball and soccer combination

Q5 - Pavement colour for the court - blue / orange

Stage 1 Works – 2023-24

- 1. A full-sized futsal court with an acrylic surface, two basketball/soccer goals, fencing and drainage
- 2. Concrete path from Bakers Road to the new futsal court

Future Stage Works – Subject to Council funding

The following projects are subject to separate future capital improvement bids being supported through council's annual budget process.

- 1. Neighbourhood level playground
- 2. Enlarged picnic and bbq area with picnic table settings, BBQ, seats and drinking fountain
- 3. New gravel circuit walking path
- 4. Netball practice goal circle
- 5. New fitness equipment
- 6. Additional Park furniture seats
- 7. Tree planting
- 8. Indigenous garden beds


