June/July 2024 World Elder Abuse Awareness Day (WEEAD)



Elder abuse comes in many forms. It can be financial, emotional, psychological, physical, sexual, or social.

Elder abuse can occur once, or many times, and can vary in severity from subtle through to extreme. Most often, elder abuse is carried out by someone known to the victim, with two thirds of abusers being an adult child. Abusers can also be other family members, relatives, or friends.

The most recent study of elder abuse prevalence in Australia found that 14.8 per cent of people aged over 65 had experienced at least one recognised form of elder abuse over the previous 12 months.

Seniors Rights Victoria works to prevent elder abuse from occurring by offering free legal advice and information as well a range of educational and advocacy activities. They are committed to safeguarding the rights, dignity and independence of older Victorians.
