World Elder Abuse Awareness Day (WEAAD)

Elder abuse comes in many forms. It can be financial, emotional, psychological, physical, sexual or social.

Elder abuse can occur once, or many times, and can vary in severity from subtle through to extreme. Most often, elder abuse is carried out by someone known to the victim, with two thirds of abusers being an adult child. Abusers can also be other family members, relatives, or friends.



The most recent study of elder abuse prevalence in Australia found that 14.8 percent of people aged over 65 had experienced at least one recognised form of elder abuse in the previous 12 months.

Seniors Rights Victoria works to prevent elder abuse from occurring by offering free legal advice and information as well as a range of educational and advocacy activities. They are committed to safeguarding the rights, dignity and independence of older Victorians.

Medicare Urgent Care Clinics

If you need care for urgent but not life-threatening injuries or illnesses, you can visit a Medicare Urgent Care Clinic.

Urgent care is when you have an illness or injury that needs medical attention on the same day. It's when you can't wait for a GP appointment, but you don't need to visit the emergency department.

Medicare Urgent Care Clinics provide free, walk-in care – no referral or appointment needed.

Urgent medical care may include attending to minor fractures, sprains, minor infections, mild burns, respiratory illness, severe stomach pains or urinary tract infections.
