

2017/18 Child Friendly Event Planning Checklist

This checklist is a guide for event organisers to actively ensure their event is a child friendly environment. As a Child Friendly City, the City of Greater Dandenong is a city in which all children are valued, respected and celebrated and:

- Children are given opportunities to learn and develop their potential.
- Families, services and the broader community work together to ensure children are safe at all times and have access to services.
- Children have access to environments and services to improve their health and wellbeing.
- Children have opportunities to connect with other children, to their family, to their community and to the environment they live in.
- Children's voices are heard through consultation in planning and implementation of programs.

	Activities encourage a connection to the natural environment. Invite open ended interactions, spontaneity, risk taking, exploration, discovery and connection to nature. To foster an appreciation of the natural environment, develop environmental awareness and provide a platform for ongoing environmental education.	
	Activities include children and families participating together.	
	Activities are interactive and informative.	
	Children are given the opportunity to learn and develop their potential.	
	Children have the opportunity to connect with other children, to their family, to their community and to the environment where they live in.	
	Children are celebrated.

	SPF 30+ broad spectrum, water resistant sunscreen is available for outdoor activities.	
	Sufficient shade is available in outdoor areas. In Victoria, the average UV is above 3 from September until April and sun protection is required during 11am-3pm	
	Event staff recognise they are role models and are encouraged to use a combination of sun protection measures.	
	Children and families have access to environments and equipment which encourage active play and physical activity	
	Activities provide a safe, inclusive and empowering social environment.	
CHILD	SAFE ENVIRONMENT	
	Children are to always feel safe, secure and supported.	
	Staff are to role model appropriate behaviour for children. Encourage care, empathy, respect and optimism to promote a positive attitude to learning.	
	Provide play based learning to allow for expression of personality, uniqueness and to enhance dispositions like curiosity and creativity.	
	Activities take place in a totally smoke-free environment.	
	Families and children are key partners in developing and supporting activities and programs.

Food and drink are not used as an incentive or reward at any time.
There is an opportunity to engage in regular food-related activities such as planning and shopping for meals, growing, cooking and eating foods.
