Cat and dog reduced fee desexing voucher scheme

As veterinary practices differ in techniques and therefore pricing in regard to desexing of an animal, these arrangements allow the owner to pay the difference in cost after a discount of 25% of the advertised desexing price of the veterinary practice and the council contribution have both been subtracted.

This notice is to advise members of the discounted schedule effective from 1 January 2019.

Participating Councils have been notified by the Municipal Association of Victoria (MAV) of the new arrangements.

All conditions of eligibility remain the same and all dogs and cats must have a current vaccination certificate.

The appropriate age for desexing your pet should be determined after discussions with a veterinary practitioner.
