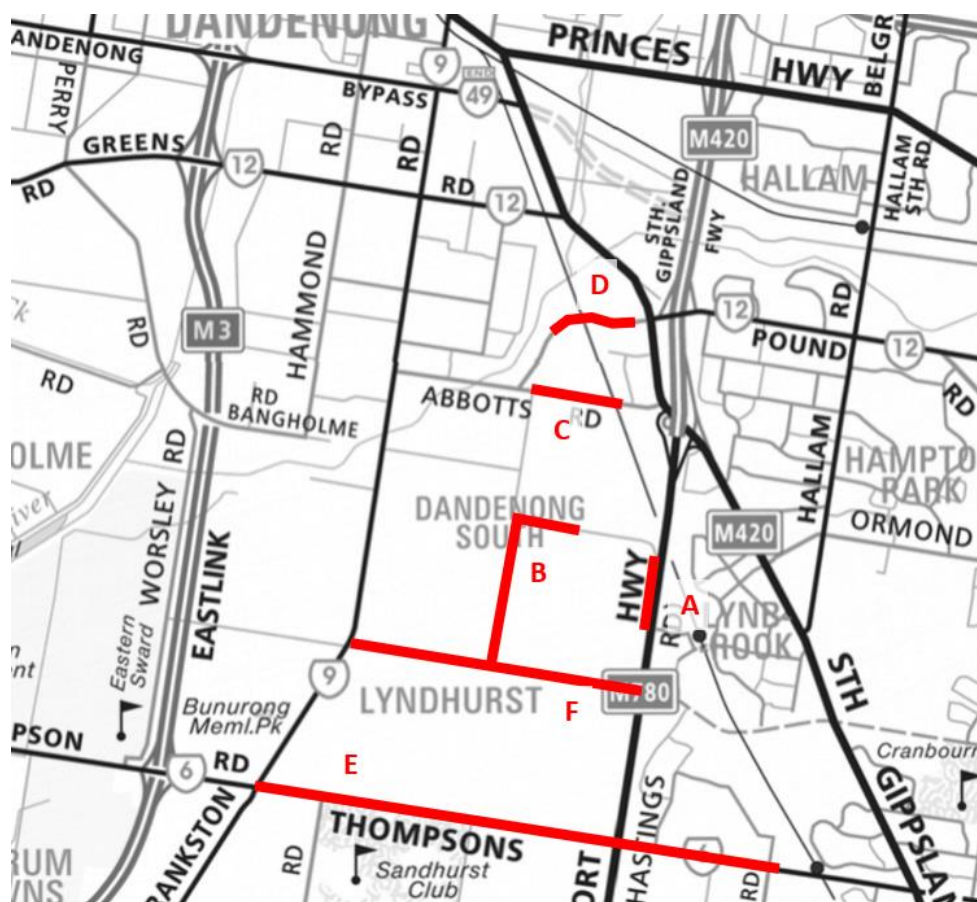


Dandenong South Road Network Changes Fact Sheet

January 2021

This fact sheet provides an update on a number of key road network projects relating to the Dandenong South National Employment and Innovation Cluster that are currently progressing.



A. Bayliss Road (from Westernport Highway)

Bayliss Road will be permanently closed at Westernport Highway from 31 January 2021. The Victorian Government is closing the road to construct a rail spur into the upcoming Inland Port development.

B. Bayliss Road (Taylors Road to National Drive) and Taylors Road (Colemans Road to Fox Drive)

Council is currently discussing a number of road infrastructure projects with local developers, it is likely that these sections of road will be constructed within the next couple of years.

C. Abbotts Road and signals at Taylors Road

The section of Abbotts Road between Taylors Road and National Drive will be widened to two lanes in each direction by Council in the first half of 2021, this will include signals at Taylors Road.

The widening of the section of Abbotts Road between National Drive and the rail line to two lanes in each direction will be considered in Council's 2021/22 Budget

D. Pound Road West Bridge

The Victorian Government is in the process of finalising designs for a package of road upgrades in the South East, which includes the Pound Road West Bridge, linking to Remington Drive. More accurate timing will be known once the designs are finalised. The package of road upgrades will be complete by 2025, though some projects will be delivered sooner.

Following the completion of the Pound Road West Bridge, Pound Road West, Remington Drive and Abbotts Road between Remington Drive and Frankston-Dandenong Road are intended to be declared arterial roads.

E. Thompsons Road Upgrades

Capacity improvements on Thompsons Road, delivered by the Victorian Government, including at the intersection of Frankston Dandenong Road are almost complete, and should provide some relief to other east-west routes through the area, including Abbotts Road.

F. Glasscocks Road upgrade

Council is advocating to the Victorian Government to intervene to fast track delivery of Glasscocks Road which will form a key part of the road network. Currently funding is not available for delivery of this project.
