
Frederick Wachter Reserve - Proposed Playground Upgrade



(1) MARKET TOWER SENIOR PLAY ZONE

Balance along the ropes course or scale the climbing wall into the Market Tower, with two adventurous coloured slides and Apple and Lemon windows to peer through from up high.

(2) JUNIOR PLAY ZONE

The junior play zone features a small slide & cubby play, rocker and balancing logs for young children. For the more adventurous there's Asparagus monkey bars and an inclusive trampoline zone.

(3) MOTION PLAY ZONE

Swing and spin with all your friends. The Motion play zone features accessible spinner, towering basket swing and hexagon swings, including toddler seat and expression swing for fun together.





Shady trees, grassy mound and picnic tables provide a space to rest and relax. A perimeter walking path with shade trees and bench seats for fitness and leisure.

ACCESSIBILITY

Accessible elements include wide softfall rubber paths to accommodate wheelchairs and prams, accessible spinner, trampoline, basket swing and expression swing, plus musical and sensory elements with the rain wheel, gong drums and sand table. Also proposed are Braille / Auslan way finding signage throughout playspace.








Sensory elements include musical elements, sand textures and nature play. Wet hands and feet in the stream bed, make sand pies in the sand pit, create a cubby and hide inside the custom Pear cubby frame, make music with the rain wheel and gong drums.




SAND AND WATER PLAY

Three large shade sails, coupled with large, mature shade trees provide sun protection over the playground. Picnic tables and grassy mounds create places to rest with views over the reserve. Benches and seats are scattered throughout, with large stone boulders double as seats and balance trails.









LANDSCAPE

Two grassy mounds provide views over the playground and reserve, which is planted with mature shade trees, and a mix of deciduous and evergreen for colour and foliage interest year round. Ornamental fruit trees continue the Market Garden theme, with Chinese Pistachio, Crab Apple and Olive.
