


Apple Devices - Sharing COVID-19 Digital Certificate with Service Victoria


1. **Update** your Service Victoria App.

2. **Tap** add Certificate via myGov




3. **Scroll** down and **Tap** on Medicare in myGov




4. Tap View history

For the purposes of this app, you consent to the sharing of your COVID-19 vaccination information to provide proof of vaccination through its app when it is required by a state or territory public health order or for other health policy purposes as advised by the State of Victoria.


You can withdraw your consent at any time. There is more information about withdrawal of consent on the [Getting help during coronavirus \(COVID-19\) - COVID-19 vaccinations - Services Australia](#) webpage. If you withdraw your consent, no further updates of your vaccination status will be shared with the Service Victoria app. Your COVID-19 vaccination information will remain on the device until you delete it.

Your consent will remain valid for 12 months, unless you withdraw it earlier. At the end of this period you will need to refresh your consent for any further sharing of your COVID-19 vaccination information.

If you choose not to share your COVID-19 vaccination information with the Service Victoria app you can continue to access your digital certificate via the Medicare Express Plus app or Medicare Online via myGov, or the IHI Member Service via myGov.
