

Proposal

Greater Dandenong City Council is planning to upgrade the Noble Park Reserve neighbourhood playground.

The project will include a diverse range of new playground equipment.

It will also include shade sails over part of the playground area.

Council is seeking the community's feedback on the draft concept plan ideas as well as other suggestions you may have.

Your ideas will help shape the design of this new playground.

Ideas and opportunities for the proposed playground

- Triple bay swing (two flat seats and one toddler seat)
- 360 degree rotating swing
- Bouncing and rotating spinner
- Play activity tower with elements such as:
 - monkey bars, fireman's pole - climbing walls and steps
 - tunnel
 - platform decks at different heights
 - roof covering

 - small and large slide wide/ enclosed slide - integrated play panels such as a shop front and driving wheel etc.
 - short length overhead track ride
- Rope net climb with flexible and static elements balancing, resting, climbing
- Musical interactive elements
- Trampoline
- Two spring rockers
