The City of Greater Dandenong is creating a new public open space on the former tennis court site at 2A Frank Street.

During November 2021, the community were invited to participate in a pre-design consultation process, with the opportunity to share their ideas on the design for this new public open space. The main themes and ideas that emerged from the community's feedback provided council with clear direction on the design for this new open space.

Concept Plan - Key design elements are:

- A paved flexible space with umbrella sockets that allows for a range of everyday or programmed uses
- A high quality landscaped space which provides shade, colourful trees and garden beds
- A relaxing space to enjoy gatherings with friends and family
- A seating wall that extends around the edge of the garden bed and stage
- A pergola and a variety of seating and table options
- A timber stage
- Clear sight lines into the space and is safe day and night.
- Provision of lighting
- The use of timber in the furniture and structures

Council thank you for your contribution which has helped shape the design of this new open space.

Next Steps

Council is now progressing towards delivering this project by June 2022.

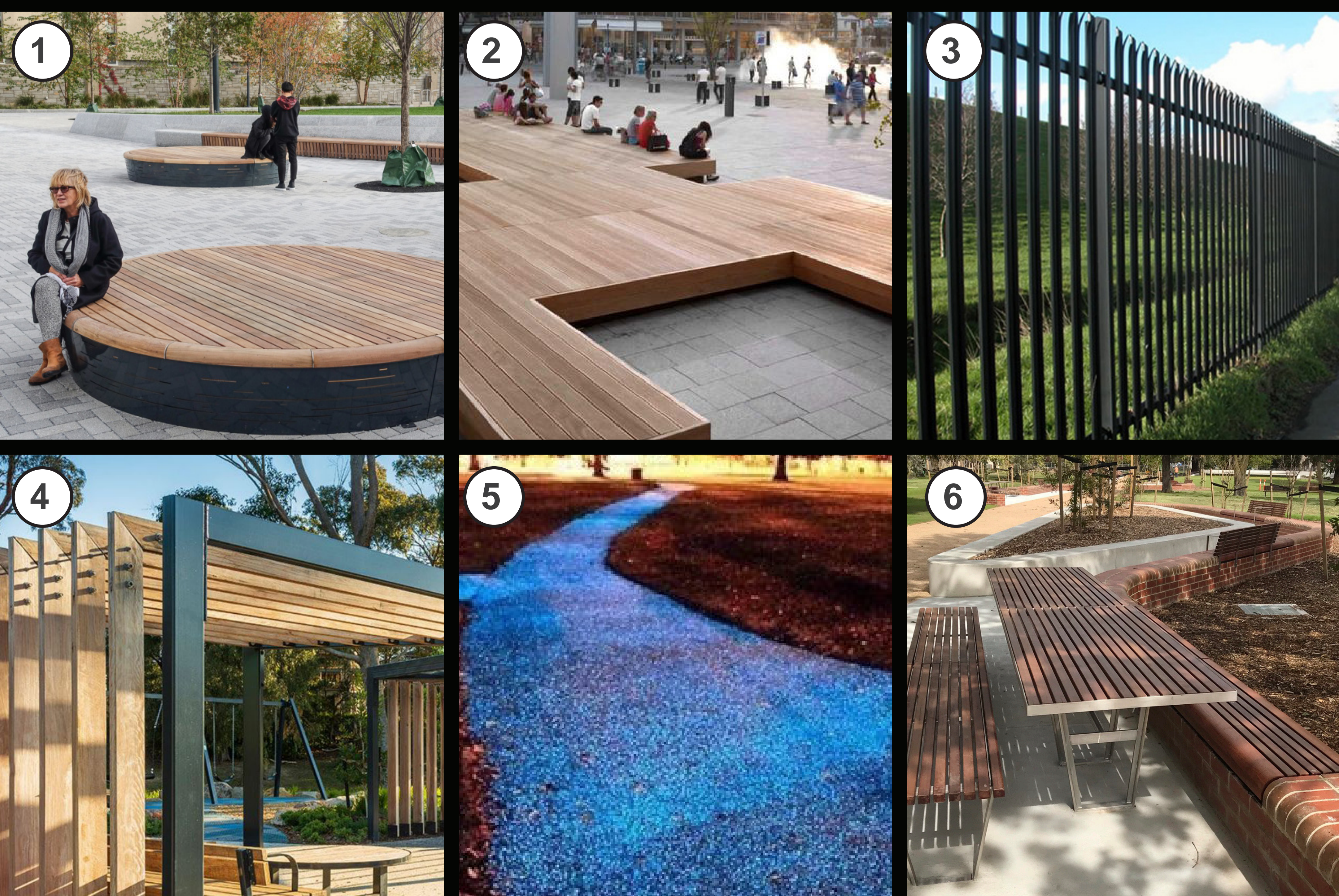
