In the Hindu Temple all head coverings should be removed except those worn as religious practice. All are asked to wear socks on entering the Mosque and women entering the Mosque are asked to cover their heads and wear clothing which covers arms to wrists and legs to ankles, men are asked to cover their heads in the Jewish Synagogue, and all are asked to cover their heads in the Gurdwara. <b>PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN HEAD COVERING FOR THE MOSQUE; head covering is only provided in the Synagogue &amp; Gurdwara.</b> Visitors should have no tobacco on their person when entering the Gurdwara.
